FAMILY RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Check/monitor your student's academic progress and attendance using Skyward Family Access – see office to get login information;

- Familiarize yourself with your student's teachers;
- Contact the school with questions or concerns;
- Participate in or attend your student's events or other activities when possible;
- Ensure your student attends school every day and is on time;
- Ensure that your student adheres to the school dress code.

STUDENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Cooperate and show respectful conduct;
- Participate in class discussions, group, and individual work;
- Complete assigned work in a timely manner;
- Always try to do my best;
- Come to school prepared;
- Attend school every day and be on time;
- Believe that I can and will learn;
- Show respect for myself, my school and other people.

STAFF RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

In order to increase student learning and success for all students, staff have the responsibility to:

- Work to develop positive relationships with all students and families;
- Come to class prepared to teach;
- Send home course expectations for each class that includes grading policies;
- Keep updated and accurate record of student progress, including attendance, in a timely manner;
- Send home progress report and communicate with families if a student is in jeopardy of failing a class;
- Return phone calls and e-mail messages within 24 business hours;
- Involve an administrator or security if a student is in danger of being removed from class;
- Take mutual responsibility for all students.
- Show respect for each student and their family;
- Seek ways to involve parents/guardians in the school.
